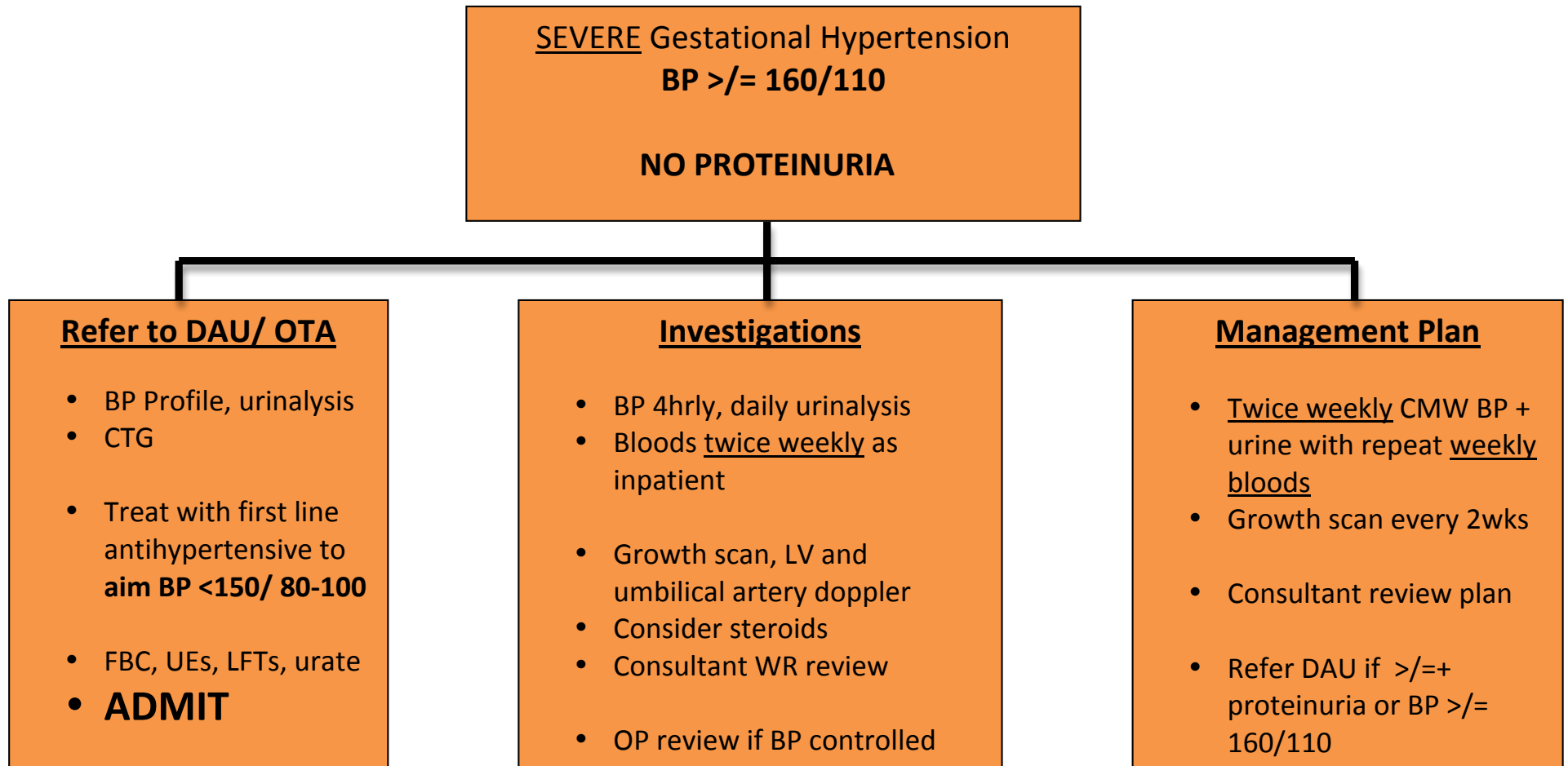


SEVERE PREGNANCY INDUCED HYPERTENSION



A full assessment of the patient should be performed:
Previous history of pre-eclampsia
Previous pregnancy induced hypertension
Pre-existing vascular or renal disease
Gestational age at presentation

This should include assessment of risk factors:
First pregnancy
Age ≥ 40 years
Pregnancy interval >10 years
BMI ≥ 35 kg/m²
Family history of pre-eclampsia
Multiple pregnancy
